Our field trips are designed for grades Pre-k thru 2nd, daycare groups, home schools, and mother's group.

- Available Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday in September and October
- 9:30, 10:30, 12/12:30 (pm Kindergarten), 3/3:30 (after school groups)
- Field trip takes about 1 ¼ hr to 1 ½ hr to complete (plan 2hr for groups over 50)
- Apple bag holds 6 apples.
- We will substitute a small pumpkin in place of apples, when there are no longer any apples for picking. (Usually in early October)
- Our Cider is pasteurized !!

Reservation and cost:

- Reservations are required by emailing joanne.roden@peabody-ma.gov Include 1st and 2nd choice of day and time. **Please fill out request form.**
- Cost is \$8.00 for Children, siblings, chaperone and Parents
- 2 teachers per class are NC
- For groups under 15 people there is a minimum charge of \$120
- We will only accept ONE payment. <u>All chaperones/parents, teachers and children must be included in payment.</u> PTO/SCHOOL CHECKS and all credit cards are accepted. **IF you MUST pay in cash LARGE bills will be accepted. (Coins, stack of singles/small bills MUST be condensed into large bills if paying in cash to help reduce check in time).** We are checking in multiple schools/trips. Counting small bills/coins will result in a delayed or shortened trip. Thank you in advance for understanding.

Arrival

- Brooksby Farm is a busy time in the Fall for field trips. It is important to allow enough time for check-in upon arrival. 10-15 minutes is recommended for the group leader to check-In at Shed with payment and FULL count of (children, teachers and chaperones).
- Please plan enough travel time. Be aware, that If you arrive late your trip may be shortened.
- We only allow fruit picking into bags supplied by our farm.DO NOT bring any other bags, they are **not allowed** in the orchard and we reserve the right to check bags as felt necessary.
- We want you to have fun, enjoy your trip, and see you again soon!

Weather and Dress:

- Field trips will be held rain or shine. It's up to you to cancel your trip. For cancellation call (978) 531-7456 X12 (leave detailed message)we will try to reschedule day if space allows.
