

SPOOKLEY'S 25th Anniversary Field Trip at Brooksby Farm

Looking to do something special and meaningful with your school group this year?

October is **National Bullying Prevention Month** and **Farm to School Month!**

Just in.... We are offering a NEW Self- Guided SPOOKLEY Storybook Walk.

Enjoy the inspiring story about Spookley the square pumpkin who teaches us about accepting and appreciating the difference in all. He is the Spokes-"Pumpkin" who discourages bullying through such a fun story in the pumpkin patch. We are happy to share this important story with everyone so we ALL can learn how to grow into Kind people.

Our field trip is designed for grades Pre K through 5th Grade

- Available Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday in **October**.
- Morning group at 10:00 and the afternoon at 12/12:30
- Plan on 1-1 ½ hour depending on age of group
- Private Self-guided storybook walk. Teachers will guide students to choose a mini pumpkin or gourd, children can visit our barn yard animals and our play yard
- Trips do not include a snack or formal talk. You may bring your own snack or lunch and enjoy at designated picnic tables
- We do require 1 chaperone per 5 children for actively reading the pages.
- The teacher will go home with 1 Spookley book for the class!

Reservations and Cost:

- Reservations are required. Go to brooksbyfarm.org to **fill out request form for SPOOKLEY**.
- Cost is \$9 for all Children (students and any siblings)
- For groups under 15 people there is a minimum charge of \$135
- No charge for teachers, school support staff and chaperones
- We prefer payment as Credit Card and PTO/SCHOOL CHECKS. If Cash LARGE bills only.

Arrival

- Brooksby Farm is a busy time in the Fall for field trips. It is important to allow enough time for check-in upon arrival. 10-15 minutes is recommended for the group leader to check-In at side yard Shed with payment and FULL count of children.
- Please plan enough travel time. Be aware that if you arrive late your trip may be shortened.

Weather and Dress:

- Field trips will be held rain or shine. It's up to you to cancel your trip. For cancellation call (978) 531-7456 X12 (leave detailed message) we will try to reschedule only if space allows.
- Dress for the weather and be prepared to spend a couple hours on the farm. Closed toed shoes, coats, raincoats/rain boots, sunscreen, bug spray may be needed. Umbrellas are allowed if raining.
