### Farm store... what you should know

- Face MASKS worn correctly covering both nose and mouth are mandatory at our Farm store per Peabody Board of Health.
- Outside **Welcome station** with sanitizer and shopping baskets/carts.
- We ask that you do not enter the store with LARGE groups.
- Children **MUST** be by your side and well behaved. They must follow the rule "look with your eyes not your hands"!
- When waiting in check-out line, have extra people wait outside please.
- Reusable Bags are allowed.
- Fall Farm store hours begin Sept 7<sup>th</sup> Open 9am to 5pm Tuesday- Sunday (closed Mondays) Store is open 1 hour after Apple picking, plan your visit accordingly!
- Stay home if you feel sick...
- We love all our customers, happy to see you all back again and stay healthy!

### APPLE CIDER DONUTS... what you should know

- Our Cider Donuts and cider will be available in our store on weekdays.
- You can Find them in our NEW Outside **Donut Hut** on the weekends! (start Sept 11th)
- We thank you in advance for your understanding and happy to be part of your families fall tradition.

### U-Pick Fruits... what you should know

- You must purchase picking bags at check-in before entering the orchard. Only paid visitor allowed into orchards. Reservations are not required.
- Customers are **not allowed to eat fruit** in the picking fields, either off the tree or from your picking bag. Wait until you leave the orchard to do any eating.
- Children need to be by your side. Our picking fields are not a play area for them to run around unsupervised. Plan accordingly that **ALL Children in your group are supervised by an adult**.
- There may be a wait to enter the PYO orchard during peak times. We thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.
- We ask that you do not **LINGER**, once you have filled your purchased bag you should exit to allow the next group to enter. No hanging around in the pick your own area! We estimate that your picking time in the orchard should last 20-30 minutes.
- With changing capacity restrictions we cannot accommodate large groups.
- Although we love dogs, please leave them at home. **Not Pets Allowed** in the orchards (Food safety restrictions).
- We recommend leaving large bags and backpacks in the car. If you must bring a large bag or backpack it will be checked before and after picking.(We do not like to do this, but we've had too many people try to take more than they want to pay for.)
